### **CIRCULAR**

The list of Open Electives offered to VI semester students of B Tech during the EVEN semester (January to June 2025), is uploaded in the LMS. All 6<sup>th</sup> semester students are hereby informed to register for one open elective through online mode (172.16.2.10/oe or guru.nmamit.in/oe).

Online registration will be kept open through 172.16.2.10/oe OR guru.nmamit.in/oe from 29/11/2024 (10.00 a.m.) to 30/11/2024 (4.00 p.m.).

Further as per the requirements of Nitte DU, all students of B Tech have to compulsorily take one foreign language course offered by NPTEL. In this session starting from Jan 20, 2025, the Institution has selected two courses. The details are as follows –

- (1) noc25-hs25- German-I
- (2) noc25-hs43- Introduction to Japanese language and culture

Students who opt for one of the above two foreign language NPTEL courses in 6<sup>th</sup> semester, must take any one course from the listed open electives offered by our faculty in 7<sup>th</sup> semester and who opt any one course from the listed open electives offered by our faculty in 6<sup>th</sup> semester must take one of the two foreign language NPTEL course in 7<sup>th</sup> semester. Students who opt for HU1504-1, "Introduction to Japanese Language" offered by Prof. Harikrishna Bhat need not take any foreign language courses offered by NPTEL.

The students who are registering for one of these foreign language NPTEL courses have to register individually through the NPTEL portal on or before Jan 6, 2025. Further they need to do online registration as described above (for open electives offered by our faculty) within the deadline, so that the Institution can know how many students have registered for one of these courses.

The examination fee of Rs.1000 (which will be paid to NPTEL) will be collected along with the other examination fees at the beginning of next academic year.
