
**CIRCULAR**


Online registration links will be kept open from 26/05/2026 (10.00 a.m.) to 31/05/2026 (4.00 p.m.).

- 2) Students should only Register for the Open Electives which is not taken by them during 6<sup>th</sup> semester (January to April 2026).
